October 4, 2023 (Rescheduled from September 20, 2023)

Roll Call - Present: Corey Benedict, Barbara Miller, Brent Humphrey, Laura Offerdahl, Gail Sievert
Absent: Betty Barth, Tiffany Cannon, Kitty Steidel, Cindy Wilt

Excused: None Guest: Mickey Ford (regular Member in good standing)

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm (Eastern), by the President, Corey Benedict

Report of the President: It was brought before the Board by a Board member that Betty Barth had communicated her desire to resign as the Vice President. After due discussion the following motion was made:

Motion #01-09-23 Brent moved to accept the verbal resignation of Betty Barth for the office of Vice President, effective immediately. Gail seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. A letter from the Secretary will be sent about this action to Betty.

The Board continued their discussion on fulfilling the vacancy with the following motion brought before the Board:

Motion #02-09-23 Brent moved to have Barbara Miller assume the office of Vice President immediately and Mickey Ford to assume the office of Secretary immediately. Laura seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Both Barbara and Mickey accepted the respective offices.

Report of the President: Corey introduced Micky Ford as Secretary and announced Barbara Miller as Vice President.

Report of the Vice President: No report at this time.

Report of the Secretary: The minutes of the October 4, 2023, Board meeting was circulated to the Board members prior to the meeting for review.

Brent brought up that Betty Barth had been sent a letter stating that the board had accepted her resignation. Micky Ford received the registration mail card that Betty had accepted and signed.

Brent explained the reasoning behind the change. Brent will work on securing an area/room for the Welcome Party and suggested having the Annual Meeting at the same time to keep members there. Judges (Kitty & Nick) have agreed to do Ringside Mentoring at these shows.

Foundation: The vacancy on the Foundation Board has been filled by Terry Howell from upstate New York. Brent explained the process for the clinical trials (Long Legs and stated the first trial is underway. Hopefully a report will be generated soon, a second trial has been approved.

Newsletter: Brent led a discussion on the possibility of having Obedience & Hunt Work at shows. Anything you want in future Newsletters should be sent to the Committee.

Membership: Brent presented Jane Milaschewski from Florida, a new applicant for Associate Membership. With **Motion #02-11-23** Brent moved to accept; Gail seconded, and motion passed unanimously.

Judges Ed: Nick Frost did not renew, but indicated that he would like to continue doing presentations on behalf of the club. Corey proposed that Nick become an honorary member which is a requirement to do the presentations. As a non-member, he would not pay dues and cannot vote.

Kitty led discussion on ringside mentoring, Corey will send rules documents to her. She will work on developing a form for prospective mentors which would include experience and willingness to attend shows. Kitty also led a discussion on a laminated card for judges and mentors with photos and breed specifications.

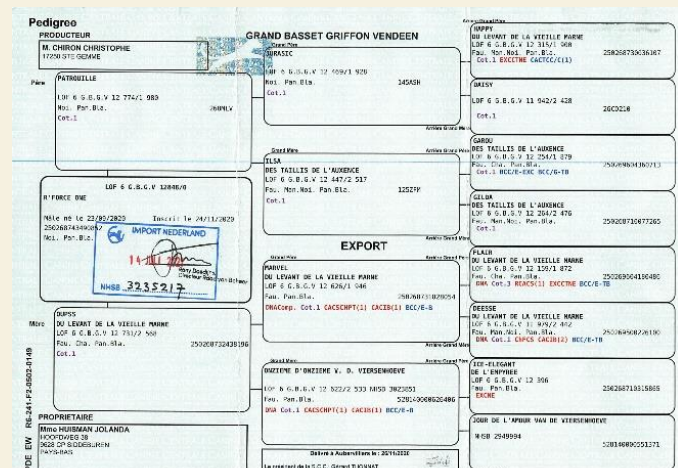

The One, Two, Threes of

I began my journey to France, with a side trip to the Netherlands, when I wanted to create a 3-generation pedigree of my GBGV, T-Bear (CH Sidekick's Brijolne Cor de Chasse Is Oso Bodacious). His co-breeder sent me a copy of his sire's Export Pedigree, but alas, it was all in French! So, I, with my rudimentary French, and Google Translator, dug in. I learned some very interesting facts.

The picture to the left is the key to what the abbreviations on the pedigree mean. This key pertains to ALL breeds accepted in France, not just GBGVs.

The titles in Red are certain working titles.

The titles in Blue are certain working "tests" that can be completed by defined groups of dogs.

The information in the brown area lists colors and patterns available for all the breeds registered in France.

The smaller brown box defines the genetic testing and/or verification done.

The final maroon box is for "Breeders Quotes (Ratings)" pertaining to breeding.

The One, Two, Threes of Export Pedigrees

France's registry system is the "Livre des Origines Francais" (LOF). It is the French version of the AKC.

France uses the 10 Categories of breeds set forth by the "Federation Cynologique International" (FCI). The 10 Categories are like the 7 Groups in the United States.

The Categories are:

1. Sheepdogs and cattle dogs (except Swiss cattle dogs)
2. Pinschers and schnauzers - molossoïd breeds - Swiss mountain and cattle dogs and other breeds
3. Terriers
4. Dachshunds
5. Spitz and primitive types
6. Scent hounds and related breeds
7. Pointers and setters
8. Retrievers - flushing dogs - water dogs
9. Companion and toy dogs
10. Sighthounds

I was able to decipher the page of keys to the point that I understood what most of the abbreviations stood for that could appear on a dog's pedigree, both Conformation and Working titles. I was able to determine which group of dogs the working tests pertained to. I figured out all of the colors and markings they used. And I translated the Breeders Quotes (Ratings) 1-6.

So, I took this information back to the pedigree itself and continued researching.

By entering the names of the dogs in the pedigree in a search engine, I was able to find show results on some of them on a couple of French show pages just as we can here in the USA find dogs listed on different superintendent's pages.

I learned that in France, ALL pets must be microchipped. If you take an animal into France, one of the first things a vet will do is locate an existing microchip or insert one if the animal is not chipped already. I found the French microchip registry and once I determined what numbers on the pedigree corresponded to microchips (that was a palm plant to the head – DUH moment), I was able to look up the numbers and see the dog's information entered in the registry. The microchip registry in France is "Identification des carnivores domestique" (I-CAD).



This is the entry on the pedigree for R' Force One, T-Bear's sire. As you can see, he is a male born on 23/09/2020 (September 23, 2020). The dog for whom the pedigree is issued is the only dog showing a birth date.

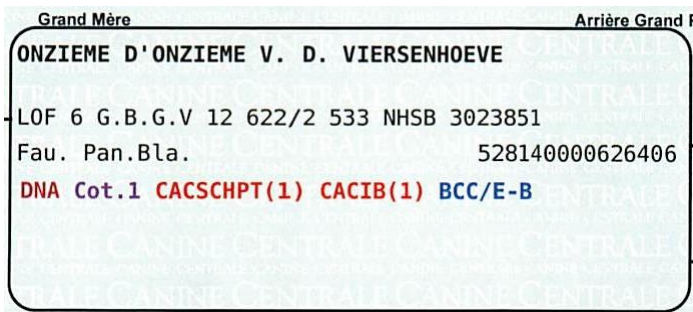
This pedigree was produced (written) on 24/11/2020 (November 24, 2020). His color is designated as Black (noir (Noi.)), Variegated (panachure (Pan.)) White (blanche (Bla.)).

His French registration number, LOF 6 G.B.G.V. 12848/0, means he is registered with the Livre des Origines Francaise. The 6 is the FCI Category he belongs to, Scent hounds and related breeds, the G.B.G.V. is his breed, and 12848/0 is the number of his registration.

The One, Two, Threes of Export Pedigrees

You will note that his entry also shows he was imported to the Netherlands 14 Juli (July) 2021. The Netherlands registry is the “Nederlands Honden Stamboek” (NHSB, Dutch Dog Studbook). Several of the dogs in this pedigree show NHSB registration numbers meaning they are separately registered in 2 countries.

The 15-digit number 250268743490852 is R' Force One's microchip number. Not all microchip numbers in this pedigree are 15 characters. Some are 6 and 7.



This entry on the pedigree is for R' Force One's Grandmother. The V. D. in the name is short for “Van De” I found that out when I found show results for her.

As you can see, she is registered both in France and the Netherlands (both LOF number and NHSB number).

She is Tawny, Variegated White (Fau. Pan. Bla.)

The brown “DNA” on her entry means that the genetic identification of the subject has been carried out.

“Cot. 1” is a Breeders Quote (Ratings) of 1, meaning she has been confirmed as a possible breeding female.

The two red conformation abbreviations (CACSCHPT(1), CACIB(1)) mean she is a French Champion and an International Champion.

And the blue BCC/E-B mean she was in a hunting test and received an Excellent against Wild Boar.

It was an extremely interesting web trip to say the least. I feel that I learned a great deal about French and Dutch registries, and I even learned a few more bits and pieces as I was writing this article.

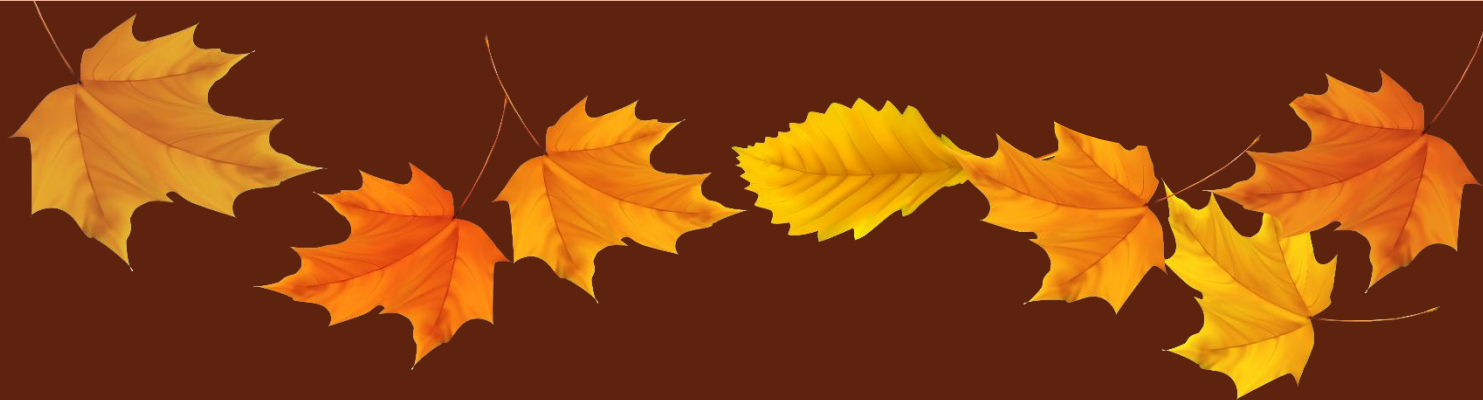
