January 31, 2024

Roll Call - Present: Barbara Miller, Brent Humphrey, Gail Sievert, Tiffany Cannon, Micky Ford, Cindy Wilt
Excused Absence: Kitty Steidel, Corey Benedict **Absent:** Laura Offerdahl
Meeting called to order at 7:06pm (Eastern), by the Vice President Barb Miller
Report of the President: Corey was absent.

Report of the Vice President: Barb questioned if we need a motion to have Nick Frost designated for honorary member status in order to do ringside mentoring. Brent said motion not needed. Corey already contacted Nick and he was OK to do the mentoring.

Report of the Secretary: The minutes of the November 15, 2023, Board meeting minutes were circulated to the Board members prior to the meeting for review. Micky brought up a typo that had been corrected for the final minutes and Corey was added at a non-judge ringside mentor.
Motion #01-1-24 Brent moved to accept the minutes as corrected. Gail seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Report of the Treasurer: The report reflected an ending balance as of 12/31/2023 of \$14,108.49. Brent reported that the trophies have been purchased for the upcoming specialty. He said there had been a few expenses. Donations have been low so far. Report will be committed to file.

Committee Reports

2024 National/Regional: Brent stated that he has been working on a caterer for the award dinner and silent auction. The welcome party and annual meeting will probably have to be in the grooming area or by an RV, Brent will follow up. Due to low donations, the trophies will probably have to be funded by the club. The host hotel (Hampton Inn) phone number has been corrected. Gail started discussion on Judges Ed at the Blue Grass Specialty Club and nationals. Brent has received the judges panel from Gail and will send the list to the board and submit for review.

Foundation: The resignation of Michelle Clark has been accepted. We are now down 1 member.

Newsletter: Brent stated the next issue is being worked on, no date given for delivery.

Membership: None

Judges Ed: Corey and Kitty have done some remote mentoring for judges. Gail asked about the possibility for Judges Ed at the Kentucky shows and Brent informed her that the minimum attendance needed to be 6 participants with a 90-minute presentation and 60-minute hands-on period. Barb initiated discussion on partnering with the Fauve Club which has FSS status in AKC and cannot partner at this time.

Health: Gail led discussion on trying to contact breeders not in the club but who have GBGVs and sending them a health survey. Brent said he spoke to his attorney who advised against doing this. The OFFA can do the health survey and let us know the results.

New Business: Micky received an AKC/PAC letter requesting donations. The board has chosen in the past not to support a monetary contribution and has agreed to continue to not support any donation.

Micky opened discussion on the letter from Samantha Adkins inviting the club to be in the March issue of Showsight. It was questioned if the article would be free and if it was also possible submit 1-2 articles with the possibility of revamping Corey's article for the UK and having Judges Ed come up with a second topic.

Announcements: Brent reminded us that we are short on funds for trophies for the National event and encouraged everyone to donate.

The foundation board health survey committee comprised of Terry Howell, Gretchen Tannenbaum and Julie Hamilton have been busy at work. Terry and Gail have done extensive research/work to find the best way to implement this health survey for the GBGV. They have had phone calls/discussions with representatives of the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) www.offa.org OFA works exclusively with the American Kennel Club (AKC) to record health test results on the OFA website and on AKC pedigrees and registration papers. The OFA website has several surveys, a generic survey that is wide on overreaching and specific breed surveys.

Our survey is in draft form and should be wrapped up within the next few weeks. Data is collected anonymously by the OAF to encourage the most participation possible of GBGV breeders and owners. Correspondence will be sent out to all individuals currently owning or previously owning a GBGV. This letter reviews the purpose and importance of the survey and encouraging participation. Keep your eyes open for correspondence regarding this extremely important project! The board would like to thank Terry and Gretchen for their dedication and time, pushing this project to fruition.

The Foundation Board and Silent Auction Chair would like to express gratitude and thanks to the amazing support provided by Brent's staff, Amanda and Jenna.
